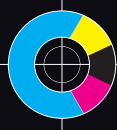

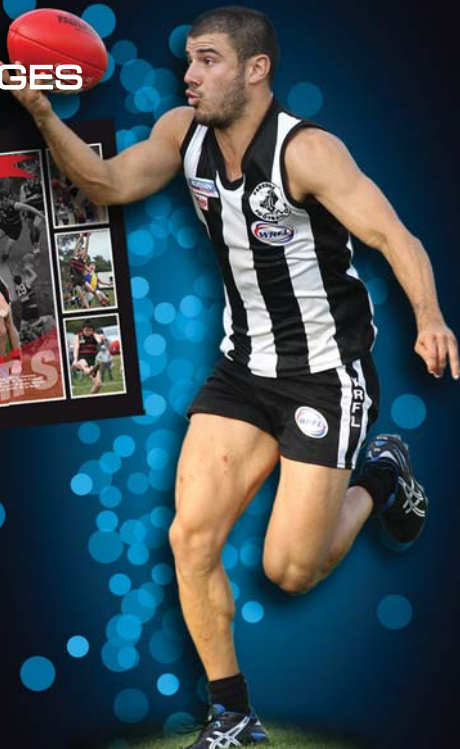

With such a young group our recruiting focus has been on experience and strong bodies and we’ve been able to get a number of former players back to the club. Stephen Pearce and Ali Asaad are both back for 2012, whilst John Bell and Simon Collis are two previous recruits who have yet to play a senior game at the club due to injury but have had terrific pre-seasons and will be ready to play. Football is back! After a long off-season of rumour, discussion, movement & hype, senior football returns to the west this weekend. And what a busy off-season it has been! Key players moving in & out of the league, some shock coaching departures & appointments, and the occasional off-field saga to keep the rumour-mill turning over.

Perhaps the biggest shock off the off-season was the departure of Marcus Barclay, whose tenure at Albion was not extended despite guiding the Cats to a grand final berth and a home & away win-loss record of 17-1. It was always going to be a tough ask for Barclay after adopting the then reigning premiers, however most thought he had done enough by season's end to have his contract extended. Instead the board opted to appoint Mark Greenshields, who coached Melton Central in the RDFL in 2011 & has spent time as an assistant-coach to Steve Kretziuk at the Western Jets.

There will also be a new face at the helm of fellow finalists Port Colts in 2012, after the departure of Peter Lunt and the appointment of Ben Burke. It's an in-house appointment for the Colts with Burke serving as the senior side's assistant coach in 2011, and the reserves side's assistant coach in 2010. A long time member of the club stretching right back to his junior days, Burke will be entrusted to return the Colts to their glory days of last decade when the side made six grand finals & won two premierships.

A significant figure in those glory days down at Murphy Reserve was Jason Clarke, who has returned to the coaching fold in 2012 as the Senior Coach at North Footscray. The 37 year-old spent seven seasons in the top job at Port Melbourne, leading the Colts to six grand finals & two premierships and winning the league's two highest honours, the Barry Priest Medal & Andrew Gibson Medal. Clarke has a big job ahead with the Red Devils who won just three games last season after gaining promotion to the

top flight in 2011 for the first time in 27 years.

The final new face into the Division One coaching arena is Mark Anderson, who is touted by many as one of the region's leading up & coming coaches. In a major coup for Sunshine Heights, the Dragons appointed the former Taylors Lakes, Tullamarine & Airport West player who had most recently spent time as co-coach at Airport West.

On the player front there have been plenty of notable departures with some key figures moving clubs, leagues or just hanging up the boots. The exodus at Parsons Reseve started quickly after Barclay's departure, the biggest loss that of Shaydon Bloomfield with the centurion goal-kicker defecting to Lara in the GDFL. Other losses for the Cats this season include Marcus Smith, Shylo Smith & Romain Grenville. Other departures across Division One include Jason Butty (ex-Hoppers Crossing), Scott Elridge (North Footscray), Aaron Henneman (St Albans), and Simon Wiggins & Ben Foley (Sunshine).

Despite losing Jason Butty the Warriors were one of the biggest winners of the off-season, their pickups including Kade Carey & Aaron Ramsey both from the EDFL. Spotswood will welcome back Lachlan McGhie & Matthew Fogarty after stints in other leagues, while Division One newcomers Deer Park have bolstered their premiership winning line-up after raiding the lists of Keilor & Maribyrnong Park in the EDFL. Key signings include Chris Stewart, Josh Jones & Gareth Daley from Marby, as well as Rhett Ring, Nick Medcalge & Brendan Bonnacci from Keilor.

Spotswood will no doubt start the season as early favourites but you could throw a blanket over the next half-dozen sides, with the big question marks over whether Deer Park will be competitive enough in the top flight to challenge for the flag, and how far off the pace Albion will be after the internal fallout over summer.

DIVISION ONE (U18)

Point Cook Nominate to Play in WRFL

The Division One under-18 competition will feature nine sides in 2012, after Point Cook Football Club opted to play in the Western Region Football League despite earlier indications the club would only be fielding an under-18 side in the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

The Bulldogs had initially hoped to field up to three sides at this level in 2012, with the intention of developing a side to play in the VAFA under-19 competition while retaining their presence in the WRFL under-18 competition.

"The addition of a ninth side ensures games can be aligned with each team's seniors & reserves every week with the exception of 'bye' rounds," said Newton.

"Point Cook will also have their home games aligned with their seniors & reserves for the majority of their fixtures."

"The side would have been offered a spot in the Division One competition last season, however two clubs nominated under-18 sides & subsequently withdrew them on the eve of the season starting."

Point Cook went on to win the Division Two premiership last year after an unbeaten home & away season.

Point Cook President, Steve Ward, said it was still the longer term aim of the club to field an under-19 side in the VAFA, while retaining their presence in the WRFL at an under-18 level.

Joining Point Cook in Division One for Season 2012 will be reigning premiers Hoppers Crossing, along with previous winners Altona Crossing (last flag in 2007), Spotswood (2004), Sunshine (1993), Albion (1992), St Albans (1988), Deer Park (1984) & North Footscray (1937).
