PRESIDENT'S WELCOME

The Executive of the Western Region Football League extends a big welcome to all members & clubs, as we return for another season of local football in Melbourne's west. In 2012 our game continues to face challenges that we as an organisation need to overcome to further the growth of our league and maintain our presence in the rapidly evolving north west corridor.

We need to be proactive in taking advantage of the huge growth in the western suburbs, with rival leagues such as the Victorian Amateur Football Association vying for a greater stronghold in the area. Amateur football is slowly growing their profile in the west, and it is important that we maintain the strength of our league by ensuring our senior clubs remain in the WRFL, while also helping establish junior clubs in newly founded suburbs.

Rival football competitions also pose a big threat in the forthcoming future, and soccer is obviously a prime example of a code that is challenging Aussie rules football. As a league we really need to think about how we tackle these challenges by alternative codes & alternative competitive leagues.

It is also paramount that the league remains umpire-friendly, as without these men, women, boys & girls in white, our league is simply unviable. Our growth in umpire numbers has been significant over the past five years, and is a sign that we are moving in the right direction in terms of promotion, support & retention within the umpiring fraternity.

The strength of our umpiring ranks, and their ability to

control the on-field play, has also resulted in a decrease in the number of reports, with a 25 percent reduction in tribunal cases over the past two seasons. The number of reportable incidents has also gone down. The greatest test of any competition, anywhere in the world when it comes to sport, is the ability to attract young people to the game and to umpire. I'm pleased to say as a real measure of our success and our performance over the past two or three years we've tripled the number of umpires who have come to the game.

Our relationships with key football stakeholders in the west is also a vital part of the growth & promotion of our league, and our relationship with the Western Bulldogs has strengthened greatly since our team moved into the Western Bulldogs administrative buildings at Whitten Oval. This partnership will be further developed throughout 2012, as we integrate our two organisations with one another for the best possible outcomes for both parties. This means greater exposure for our league, and more importantly will see the Bulldogs play a greater role with the development of our interleague & junior programs.

Our league shares similar aims & objectives with the Western Bulldogs, and also faces many of the same challenges, and a collaborative approach out here in Melbourne's western suburbs will undoubtedly ensure the best possible outcome for our great game.

DEVELOPING THE NORTH WEST

AFL Victoria appoints Darryl Collings

As part of AFL Victoria's strategy to grow & develop football in the west, the Western Region Football League welcomes AFL Victoria's Darryl Collings to the WRFL office as part of his revised role as AFL Victoria's North West Planning Manager.

Collings responsibilities in this role will require him to contribute to the management and coordination of football related stakeholders in the rapidly growing north west region of Melbourne, including supporting the Western Region Football League to help achieve league objectives and produce mutually beneficial outcomes for both organizations.

AFL Victoria's General Manager, Grant Williams, said the role will be primarily responsible for growth corridor planning in Melbourne's north-west, specifically, but not limited to, the local governments areas of Wyndham, Brimbank, Melton & Hume.

"The key requirement of the role will be to establish a coordinated approach between the AFL, AFL clubs, VFL clubs, AFL Victoria, community leagues, councils, Auskick centres & schools in the region to seize the opportunities that exist for Australian Football in this rapidly expanding region including participation growth," said Williams.

"In addition, this position will support the planning and creation of new Auskick Centres, new community football clubs and, in conjunction with local councils, examine and help plan for the future infrastructure requirements."

Collings said he was looking forward to establishing a close working relationship with all stakeholders including the WRFL, and playing a key role in the growth of participation throughout the north west region of Melbourne.

"I am very excited about taking on this role, and the opportunity it presents to work with all football stakeholders in the region to get the best

Key tasks of Collings role include supporting community leagues in the region with their endeavours for growth and future planning, overseeing the establishment of new community football clubs within the growth areas of the west and north-west corridors, and ensuring the delivery and execution of the 'North West Corridor' project to facilitate mutually beneficial relationships between all stakeholders in the area.

Collings background in club development and planning is ideally suited to the requirements of this newly created role and he will primarily be based at the Western Region Football League offices.

Deer Park's Roaring Start To 2012

Football returned to the western suburbs with a bang last weekend, as Spotswood and Deer Park showed they are both the real deal heading into season 2012. The wins to both the Woodsmen and the Lions didn't come as a great shock to many, but the margins provided a real talking point after the round's football was completed.

Spotswood were comprehensive in their destruction of Albion, with the Grand Final rematch a blowout of epic proportions. Spotswood ran rampant in the first quarter against the Cats, kicking eight goals to none before eventually running out 151 point winners.

Jason Butina battled hard for the Cats, as did Nathan Doherty & Patrick Savage, but the minor premiers didn't stand a chance against the might of Spotswood. It was always going to be an uphill battle for Albion following the departure of a host of top-tier players including Shaydon Bloomfield, Romain Grenville, Shylo Smith, Marcus Smith and Glenn Manton – but few predicted it would be as one-sided as it was.

Spotswood now travel to Deer Park in Round Two, and never before has there been more interest in a clash of the newly promoted Division Two premiers and their Division One equivalent. Many expected Deer Park to be competitive in Division One and a finals berth was considered to be a realistic goal, however based on last weekend's result the Lions definitely have the cattle to be real contenders in 2012.

They were emphatic in their first game after promotion last weekend – stunning St Albans by 90 points – a result that had even the loyalist of Deer Park supporters somewhat surprised. They were unstoppable in the Friday night fixture, making the transition from the second tier to the top grade look like little more than a change in opposition.

Deer Park co-coach Nick Condos said the Lions first big test had gone exactly to plan.

“You come up to Division One and you're

expecting and hoping everything goes to plan and everything went our way today,” said Condos.

“You've got to try and ride out the storm, which we did, and we then were lucky enough to break the game open.”

The result was even more remarkable given the absence of their key forward James Condos, who left the ground early in the piece with a strained groin. Condos racked up a remarkable 150 goals for the Lions in 2011, and despite his absence last weekend the Lions were able to continue to run rampant up forward.

Bosko Micevski was the main firepower up forward with six majors, while ruckman Chris Stewart utilised his height in the forward line to kick three goals as well. Stewart's performance will have a few fellow Division One sides slightly concerned, as the recruit from Maribyrnong Park in the EDFL dominated aerial contests and showed he had enough stamina to run out a full four quarters.

The usual suspects of Robert Trajkovski, Dean Stankovic & Luke Summers were also amongst the best for the Lions, while ex-Sunshine midfielder Ben Foley slotted seamlessly into the team's well polished game-plan to add yet another dimension in the middle of the park.

All eyes will now be on the clash of the premiers this weekend as Deer Park host Spotswood. The Lions will unfurl their premiership flag before taking on the most dominant WRFL side of the past decade, and may have to do it without two of their key players.

Condos' ankle injury suggests it may be 2-3 weeks on the sideline for the side's playing-coach, while Robert Trajkovski did leave the field last week with an ankle complaint but is expected to play.

UMPIRES CORNER

The AFL is always looking for different ways to promote football, and in particular increase the participation of the umpiring fraternity. One of the league's more recent initiatives to boost numbers in this field is the introduction of the 'Green Shirt Program', which has now been running for several years. Most spectators at WRFL games would have witnessed the occasional umpire wearing a green shirt. This is to signify that the umpire is in his or her first season of umpiring whether field, boundary or in the goals. These green shirt umpires are much more prevalent in the junior grades where many of the WRFL's young and inexperienced field umpires make their first few steps into the world of umpiring.

Often the green shirt umpire is buddied up with a more experienced partner as they begin to learn the basic fundamentals of the craft. Terry McGarity, Henry McFerran, Mark Mather, Terry O'Donnell, Phil Henderson, Alan Pascoe and the like have all been mentors to the green shirt brigade, whether officially or not. Others have also assisted in a big way by offering encourage, advice and tips.

As anyone who has taken the field with a whistle taped to their fingers would know, there's a lot more to umpiring than merely blowing the whistle occasionally. One needs a variety of skills that include concentration, anticipation, positioning, decision-making, commitment, fitness, the ability to manage others, people skills, etc. The list goes on and on. Taking on umpiring, particularly in your first years, can definitely be a real challenge!

The AFL supports the Green Shirt Program by providing some of the gear for free. This includes a shirt, a whistle and various other bits and pieces to assist and help prepare the umpire at the beginning of the season. It is crucial that the newer umpires are encouraged as much as possible.



Hopefully all the WRFL's clubs, officials, players and spectators will also support our green shirt umpires by remembering that they are only in the infancy of their umpiring career. The success of this program can initially be gauged by the numbers of people who decide to give umpiring a chance. The real overall test is to see exactly how many of them continue to umpire into a second and third year and beyond.

So whenever you attend a football game spare a thought for the umpires that are involved irrespective of what colour shirt that they may be wearing. The bottom line is that they are out there for the simple reason that, just like you, they love being involved in this great game of ours.
