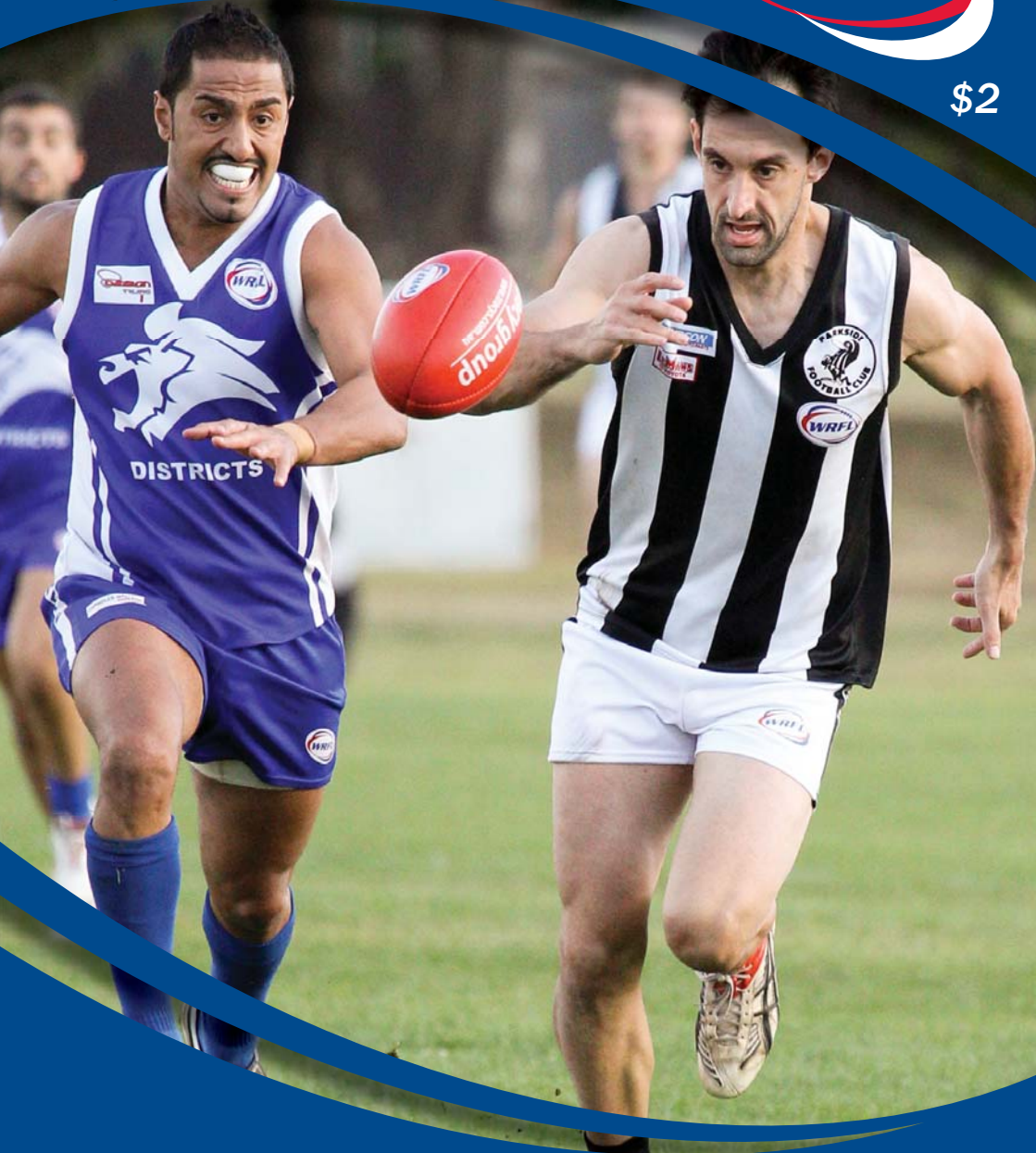

RECOGNISING OUR UMPIRES

From the Chief Executive Officer



This weekend is 'Umpire Recognition' round, an AFL led initiative which encourages everyone to respect & appreciate the excellent work that umpires do across all levels of our great game.

Too often umpires are lost to the game due to the abuse and intimidation experienced on matchday, and the aim of this weekend is for everyone to show their appreciation of those officiating our game in a bid to promote the retention & recruitment of local umpires.

Over the past three years our umpire numbers within the WRFL have almost tripled from a base of just over 100 umpires to our current numbers nearing 300. This increase has been in part due to the tireless work of a number of individuals throughout the league, as well as the promotion of our umpiring academies which has seen a large increase in the number of local juniors taking up the whistle.

This season alone there has been over 100 new umpires join the league, with a recent increase in the number of junior players that are willing to umpire on a Saturday and play on a Sunday. The

league has also attracted a large number of girls who are now realising that our game in the west is truly a female-friendly sport, as well as many new migrants who are discovering the possibilities that exist in playing & officiating within the league.

With so many new faces entering the fold it is paramount that as a league we continue to promote a positive matchday environment to keep these individuals in the game, and to encourage them to persist with their umpiring careers.

We often take these individuals for granted, but in reality there are plenty of young umpires who get involved in the game and then quickly drop out due to intimidation or abuse from players, coaches or spectators. This weekend we ask that you respect the men, women, boys & girls in white, and set a precedent that your club can carry forward throughout this season and beyond.

WRFL UMPIRE MAKES AFL DEBUT

Chris Esler Promoted To Elite Panel

The Western Region Football League continues to provide an ideal pathway for umpires aspiring to officiate at the highest level, with local Chris Esler the latest WRFL umpire to be promoted to the AFL umpiring panel. Esler made his debut at the MCG earlier this year, and will be a regular feature on AFL match-days throughout the season.

State Director of Umpiring, Kevin Mitchell, said Esler was an excellent umpire & athlete, and his promotion was testament to six years of hard work on the VFL list.

“Esler’s selection now makes it two field (Troy Pannell & Brett Ritchie), four boundary (Shane Jones, Tim Morrison, Drew Kowaski & Chris Esler), and four goal umpires that have progressed through the ranks from the WRFL to AFL level,” said Mitchell.

“The Western Region Football League continues to produce more umpires at an AFL level than any other region, and since 1992 the WRFL has been represented by a former umpire in all but one Grand Final.”

Current WRFL umpire Richard Watt recently caught up with Esler, to discuss his experiences of umpiring at the highest level, and his rise from a local boundary umpire to joining the AFL elite.

What was it like to take to the field in your first AFL game?

Totally unbelievable! It was an experience that I will never forget & the sore legs will help enforce the memory! I had spent six years umpiring at a VFL level, and have umpired for over a decade since starting as a year seven student in 1999 – so it was amazing feeling to finally get to an elite level.

What was your first umpiring experience?

I used to play for Aberfeldie Football Club in the EDFL, and would run the boundary on a weekend for a can of coke & a hot dog. A good friend Tod Byrush convinced me to come down to Scovell Reserve to join the WRFL umpires, and given I was then earning \$50 a game instead of a feed I was hooked!



What were your first impressions of the WRFL?

The Umpires Association was extremely welcoming and was always willing to assist. The people were fantastic, you were automatically accepted as the person you were and the variation of ages mixed incredibly well. The after training social aspect was great, although getting home late was part and parcel of it due to having so much fun mixing with so many great people. My mother was not too impressed sometimes about the late nights though given I would have school was the next day. It was such a great family environment that made it hard to go home as you felt like you were already there!

Can you remember your first game?

Yes, it was at Hoppers Crossing, running the boundary in the under-18’s with Kylie Tresidder (who is now a mum of two and well retired from umpiring!) I then moved up to Division One Reserves, and then within a matter of weeks worked my way into Division One Seniors.

What is your fondest memory of your time out in the west?

I would have to say the exchange program with Tasmania (NWUAUA) which has been running for the past twenty-two years where a field, boundary & goal umpire are swapped for a weekend to get a taste of a different competition. That was definitely a weekend I will never forget.

What are your normal training routines?

Just for this year's attempt to be considered to be elevated onto the AFL list, I would complete my

normal training & practice matches, and then follow it up with 50kms of running, 100kms of bike riding, as well as two swimming sessions a week. It's damn hard work but when you get your chance to make it at the highest level – it's worth every ache & pain.

What advice would you give to young umpires in the WRFL?

Never give up on your dream. Persist with your goals and stay on track with that dream. It took me five years to get a VFL finals gig, so you just need to stick with it, be patient, and work hard for what you're aspiring towards.

A JUNIOR UMPIRE'S EXPERIENCE

In 2011 I decided to take up umpiring within the WRFL. When I decided to do this, I didn't really know what was involved. I'd been playing footy since Under 9's & that helped as at least I knew the rules. I was 13 years old when I started. I attended an information seminar where we were told that umpiring was a great opportunity to be involved in footy from a different perspective, make new friends, grow in confidence & be paid for it.

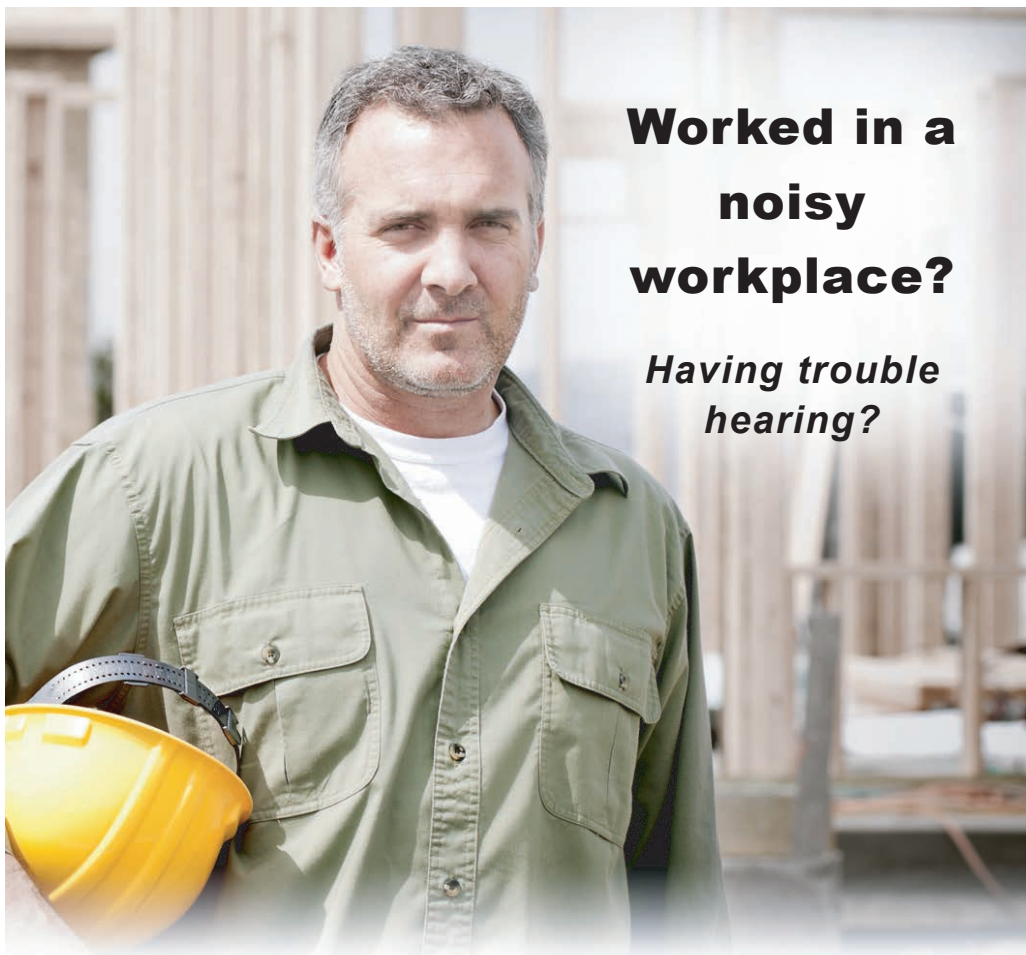
I started off by attending one of the WRFL's Umpiring Academies at MacKillop College on Monday nights where I was given a green uniform & taught the basics. The one fear I had was that I'd be on my own & find it all a little daunting. I was pleased to know that was never going to happen as there is a mentoring program in place where experienced umpires give their time to assist new umpires. Initially my mentor came out on the ground with me & as I gradually gained in confidence & experience his role lessened & he'd then talk to me at the breaks & always look to encourage me.

During the course of the season I found I picked things up pretty quickly & as I got to know many of the senior umpires my confidence grew due to the way in which they all made me feel welcome. I was pleasantly surprised to find myself umpiring finals games in my first season, but at the same time felt confident knowing what I'd been taught would stand me in good stead.



Getting involved in umpiring is something I am really pleased about. I get to remain involved in sport, continue to learn new skills, be involved with a fantastic group of people & importantly I get paid for doing something I enjoy. If you're thinking about becoming an umpire, then I would certainly encourage you to do it.

Spotswood continues to set the pace at the top of the Division One ladder, with their latest four points coming courtesy of a 61 point win over Sunshine. It was the Kangaroos first loss of the new season, having started 2012 in impressive fashion with resounding wins over Sunshine Heights & St Albans.

Sunshine coach Brett Jacobs was buoyant about his side's performance, particularly the first half which saw the Kangaroos almost match it with the form side of the competition.

"We knew we were coming down here to test ourselves and see how we measure up against the best side in the competition," said Jacobs.

"We've got a bit of work to do but we know where we sit and we'll go back and start to try and improve."

The Kangaroos were well and truly in the contest at half time with Spotswood just two kicks in front, before the reigning premiers' class prevailed in an eleven goal to four second half.

Jacobs said turnovers cost his side in the second half, with Spotswood continually capitalizing on the visitors' errors.

"We had too many turnovers," said Jacobs.

"They're such a good side that when you turn it over, they hurt you on the rebound and score against you. I thought their onballers worked a bit harder than our guys and were able to get on the end of some good plays."

Despite the loss there were plenty of positives for the Kangaroos, who now sit fourth on the Division One ladder after three rounds of football. Hayden Moloney was relentless around the packs keeping many of the Woodsmen's best players honest, while big Jacob Koroneos

also showed plenty of promise against Spotty's returning ruckman Lachie McGhie.

Staying on pace with Spotswood at the top of the table is a much-improved Altona side, with the Vikings dishing out a 196 point thrashing to the struggling Sunshine Heights. Tyler Healy kicked six for the winners & Ziad Kadour five, with Altona's early-season form adding plenty of hype to their showdown with Spotty in just over a week's time.

The other shining light on a cold & miserable day of football was the performance of Hoppers Crossing, or more importantly their key off-season signing Kade Carey who kicked four for the Warriors in their 30 point win over Albion. In a game that was determined more by the wind than anything else, 26 of the 29 goals were kicked to one end of the ground with the Warriors' first & third terms setting up their second win of 2012.

Elsewhere an undermanned Deer Park returned to the winners' list with a 55-point win against North Footscray courtesy of a ten goal return from Luke Gestier, while Port Colts moved into the top half of the ladder after running out 69 point winners against the struggling St Albans.

In this weekend's fixtures Spotswood will face their biggest challenge of the season to date as they travel to Murphy Reserve to meet the in-form Port Colts. Despite losing to Altona in the opening round of the season, the Colts have since enjoyed a 222 point win over Sunshine Heights and a 69 point win away at St Albans, and should put up a good fight against the premiers' favourites.

Elsewhere the remaining four matches may be a little more one-sided with each of the four home-sides likely to take the four points.

Falcons Finally Fire

Wyndhamvale has finally secured their first four points of the season, recovering from two ordinary outings in the opening rounds of 2012 with a shock win over ladder leaders Glenorden.

It was a massive scalp for Wyndhamvale who had been yet to fire this season, with the Falcons running out 21 point winners courtesy of a seven goal final quarter.

“We were aware that the game would split open at some point,” said Falcons coach Luke Dennerley.

“Glenorden got a hold of us in that third quarter, but to our guys’ credit our patience was fantastic and their belief in the game style was there and they came home really strong. The key for us right across the board was we were prepared to win the contested ball.”

Dennerley said his side’s tackle count almost doubled Glenorden’s, and he thought Wyndhamvale’s ruck combination of Daal Mashak & Nathan Reschke had the wood over the Hawks’ big men.

For Glenorden Tristan Angelini was amongst the best, however the on-baller went down with a torn rotator-cuff late in the game which may see him miss at least a month of football.

“Realistically we knew we were coming for a bit of a fall and it’s probably something we needed,” said Diker.

cent of our players with less than seven or eight possessions. You’re not going to win many games with that happening.”

Wyndhamvale’s win puts the Falcons back in the mix as one of the competition’s main contenders, with the other two notable form sides being Glenorden & Yarraville Seddon.

The Hawks & Eagles will play off for top spot this weekend in a match that should determine who the benchmark of the competition is.

As for Wyndhamvale their run gets a little easier over the coming fortnight as they come up against Braybrook & Albanvale.

Despite dropping games to Parkside & Coburg, Dennerley said his players were not panicking after their poor start, but did realize there was no room for complacency this season.

“I think they thought maybe it was just going to happen and their performance was going to click into gear, on the back of a really good season last year,” said Dennerley.

“But football games aren’t won on paper.”

Instead of making sweeping changes to their side in a lead-up to last weekend’s game, Dennerley stayed with the status quo believing the game plan would succeed once the players were able to execute it.

“To be successful you need to build into seasons, you can’t be at your best early,” he said.

“Our conversion, our ability to hurt teams on the scoreboard, is something that I’m going to look for in the next couple of weeks. We want guys who are able to convert and do some damage there, because obviously that scoreboard pressure’s really important and we haven’t been able to do that.”


