# NEW TARNEIT FOOTBALL CLUB TO JOIN WRFL

The rapid growth in population of Melbourne's outer west is nowhere more apparent than in the demand for new football clubs. The state government's current Growth Area Authority planning regulations are driving the provision of new, state-of-the-art playing facilities in the early stages of development of new housing estates. In many cases, complexes with two ovals, new clubrooms and attractive landscaping are delivered even before new clubs are formed. Such is the case for Wootten Road Reserve, Tarneit – the principal venue for this year's WRFL junior finals series.

After nearly two years of discussions with WRFL staff, AFL Victoria and Wyndham City Council, a group of local football enthusiasts will conduct a formal meeting next Monday night to incorporate Victoria's newest club, the Tarneit Football Club. The club's interim secretary, Luke Gatti has already made a formal application to the WRFL for the new club to be admitted to WRFL membership. A special general meeting of all WRFL Club Delegates has been called for Wednesday August 21 to consider the club's application.

Gatti, whose full-time role is General Manager of Collingwood's VFL team, said his group was excited at the challenge of growing football at both junior and senior levels in the Tarneit local community.

"With Auskick already running at Wootten Road Reserve and a long list of prospective senior players already registering interest, we're confident of getting both senior and junior teams off the ground in our first year," he said. "We've had terrific support from Wyndham Council, Tim Shellcot at the WRFL and Darryl Collings from AFL Victoria in getting to this stage and we're really keen to get moving in time for the start of the 2014 football season."

WRFL CEO Bob Tregear said he was happy to support the formation of a new club at Tarneit.

"We know that some of our existing clubs will be concerned for the possible impact on their player numbers, but the enormous growth

in the local area population seen in the last couple of years shows no signs of stopping, so we're confident that any impact will be minimal. It's unlikely that Tarneit will have more than two or three younger-age junior teams in its first couple of years, unlike Manor Lakes and Sanctuary Lakes who fielded fourteen teams between them in their start-up this year." Tregear said that the WRFL Board is developing new by-laws to limit the numbers of players transferring between member clubs in any year to minimise impacts on existing clubs.

Assuming successful admission to the WRFL on August 21, the new club may seek to engage the Tarneit community in the choice of club colours, mascots and theme song. Anyone wishing to be involved either on-field or off-field with Tarneit Football Club should contact the WRFL office for referral to club officials.

# FEMALE FOOTBALL ALIVE AND WELL IN THE WEST

Female football in the west is alive and well, through the introduction of the combined Western Region Football League (WRFL) and Essendon District Football League (EDFL) Youth Girls competition.

Originally run by AFL Victoria in 2011, the Youth Girls competition allows keen female football players aged 13-18 years old to continue to play the sport they love, in an all women competition.

After reviewing the numbers of Youth Girls teams at the end of last year, the WRFL decided to combine the competition with the EDFL in order to create a more competitive outlet for females to play football.

“Looking at the team numbers across both leagues, the EDFL and WRFL felt it was best for the future development and great competition balance to merge the competitions,” WRFL General Manager of Football Operations, David Newton said.

“The two leagues have always had a good relationship due to the geography of both leagues, and even combined to field one Youth Girls Interleague team last year who competed in the AFL Victorian Metropolitan Championships, which was a great success.”

With the EDFL fielding five Youth Girls teams and the WRFL four teams this season, the fixture was structured accordingly, sharing the number of home and away games equally so that two matches were played at one venue in both leagues on a weekly basis.

“For a long time, girls have been participating in boys football up to and including Under 14s, so by having a dedicated girls competition, it provides greater opportunities for girls to play at a level which is consistent with their development,” Newton said.

This year, there is currently 120 girls strapping on the boots in the WRFL each week with Altona Juniors, Deer Park, St. Albans and Wyndhamvale all fielding Youth Girls sides, whilst Craigieburn, Pascoe Vale, St. Francis/Oak Park, Sunbury and Melbourne University represent the EDFL.

Whilst the Youth Girls competition is alive and well, so too is the Under 13 Girls division, which involves four WRFL clubs, including league newcomers Manor Lakes.

Differing slightly to the regular under 13s competition, the Under 13 Girls division has been modified similar to the under 9s and 10s, whereby the main focus of the game is based on skill development and participation, rather than keeping score.

“It was acknowledged that there was a considerable drop off in female participation from Auskick to Junior Football,” Newton said.

“The Under 13 Girls competition was created as a way to increase opportunities for girls wanting to continue to participate in football beyond Auskick.”

Whilst the Under 13 Girls season officially came to a close last week, the Youth Girls finals series is heating up, with Sunbury set to play Pascoe Vale in the preliminary final at Oak Park this week.

“It’s been great to see teams from both the WRFL and EDFL participate in the finals series which will further strengthen the aligned competition in 2014,” Newton said.

The west’s St. Albans Spurs team will be eagerly awaiting the outcome of this week’s preliminary final to see which EDFL team they will face in Grand Final.

Whoever it is, the 2013 Youth Girls Grand Final on Saturday August 24 will be a memorable one, with the occasion marking the first ever WRFL V EDFL Grand Final.

# WRFL GRADUATES

## Former St. Bernard's player Mitch Wallis makes his mark at the kennel

Growing up playing his junior football at the St. Bernard's Football Club with best friend Tom Liberatore, Mitch Wallis has gone from strength to strength in his AFL career, continuing to play alongside his mate at the Western Bulldogs Football Club. Recruited by the Bulldogs in 2011 under the father-son rule, Wallis has become a vital senior member at the kennel, racking up over 200 disposals in the midfield this season and ranking fifth in the Charles Sutton Medal in 2012. This week, the former WRFL player took time out of his busy schedule to chat to us about his junior days, AFL career and his lucky bathers.

### **Tell us a little bit about your football career as a junior player:**

"I was very sort of fortunate in my junior days, as I played with a bit of strong side right the way through, we played in three grand finals and won all three, in the St. Bernard's top age 12s, 14s and 16s.

So I first played when I was bottom age under 9s, when I was 7 years old and I played with my best mate Libba, who I'm obviously lucky enough to play with now at the Bulldogs. So we played right through together."

### **Do you still keep in contact with anyone from the club?**

"Tom's dad Tony Liberatore, still coaches Tom's little brother down at St. Bernard's who I think is Under 12s at the moment, and I think they have a pretty good side as well. I've got a younger brother as well, and he is with the Under 18s this year, and his got school commitments this year so he hasn't played as much this year, but last year he was top age under 16s and he played right through as well, so it was good to watch the boys play again."

### **What was the best piece of advice a coach has said to you which still stays with you today?**

"My Under 12s State coach, Andy Nicol once said to me, "It's very important to work on your weaknesses, but it's nearly twice as important to work on your strengths so they remain your strengths." In my junior days I was fairly gifted aerobically, so as much as I was working on my skills I was trying to get fitter than everyone as well, which at the end of the day is important and sets you apart from everyone else."

### **Did you have any pre-game rituals as a kid?**

"I always wear bathers, under my footy shorts, and

I sort of have a stock standard meal before the game which includes a bowl of pasta, meat and lots of veggies. The previous year's I always had the same pair of jocks I always wore, but I didn't want to get superstitious, so I changed to bathers because they last longer than jocks and I don't rely on the one pair."

### **Who has had the biggest influence of your career?**

"Probably my parents- my dad (former Western Bulldog skipper Steve Wallis) is a big influence on my football career, for his knowledge and wisdom of the game and teaching me to be the player that I am today and my mum for the person who I am, with her guidance of not letting me get ahead of myself and all the things she does behind the scenes making my life easier."

### **What advice do you have for younger kids wanting to play in the AFL?**

"I think you'll find growing up now there are plenty of opportunities to show how good you can be, whether that's when you're young at a junior level, later in the Under 18s or even the seniors. So when you do get the opportunity, you've got to make sure you take it with both hands and prove to people you're the one they want, because in this day and age, a lot of kids get drafted on attitude and not so much talent, so if you have got the right attitude and are willing to work hard, the rewards will come."
