




WELCOME TO 2013 WRFL

Round 1 2013

Welcome to the 2013 WRFL football season as the senior competitions get into full swing this weekend with the first round of Division 1 competition.

The early Easter this year enabled a WRFL-first, with St Albans and Hoppers Crossing playing their fixtured Round 3 match on Good Friday. In perfect football conditions, a crowd of more than 1,000 enjoyed a high-standard senior game under lights at Kings Park with Hoppers Crossing prevailing in the end by 16 points. Congratulations to both clubs for their vision, particularly to St Albans as hosts. The success of this ground-breaking venture provides confidence for the return match between these two clubs next year and into the future.

Round 1 of Division 2 last Saturday featured the first outings for new clubs Manor Lakes and Sanctuary Lakes. Their successful entry to WRFL competition is a taste of things to come, as the population boom in the Melton-Wyndham growth corridor drives the formation of more new clubs in coming years. We are fortunate too that Wyndham and Melton Councils are planning and delivering huge investments in high-quality, new facilities for football, providing accommodation for the new clubs as they evolve.

Wyndham Council staff have worked closely with the WRFL and AFL Victoria to establish both the Manor Lakes and Sanctuary Lakes clubs. We look forward to continuing that partnership as more new clubs are formed and new facilities developed in the years ahead.

Sunday junior competitions kick-off on Sunday 21st April, with 185 team nominations received to date. U13 Girls and Youth Girls games will be played at club venues this year, rather than at the Holland Park central venue. With the rapid population growth in the outer-west and urban regeneration in some of our inner suburbs, we can expect further growth in junior numbers for many years to come.

Last year's theme of "WRFL-Connecting Footy across the West" will continue in 2013 and into the future. Community

Football plays a major role in community development and quality of life. The WRFL is the key provider of mass-participation football in Melbourne's west; and provides the starting point for all eventual AFL-list players growing up in our region. Throughout the year we'll celebrate the rich history of the WRFL and our flourishing partnerships with the other western region football icons: Western Bulldogs, Western Jets and Werribee Football Clubs.

Our support to the EJ Whitten Foundation will continue, promoting the messages of Men's Health and inspiring young players in today's WRFL clubs to follow Ted Whitten's path from local footy to AFL stardom, hopefully with the Western Bulldogs. It's an old, but true saying, "it's not whether you win or lose- it's how you play the game that counts."

With this in mind, the Western Region Football League, in conjunction with the Western Bulldogs Football Club have developed the Western Bulldogs Heartland Award for season 2013, which recognizes a junior player, in all junior games from U9s to U14s, who displays the most sportsmanship, determination, perseverance and courageousness on the field.

At the conclusion of each match, when the two teams come together to shake hands, the coach from the home team will select one player from the opposition side, who they believe embodies the true essence of the game- that being fair play, fun, involvement, and respect for both opposition and umpires.

All junior players within the WRFL who are registered in the U9s competition, right up to the U14s are eligible for the award, with a special Heartland Award certificate presented to the winner at every home and away match throughout the year.



Earmarked as a key member in the Western Bulldogs backline, tall man Jordan Roughead has been named as the patron of this award, and could not be happier to be a part of the new initiative.

"I think it's a fantastic idea, particularly for junior teams at a grassroots level, as it shows kids that it's not all about winning, but about having fun with your mates," he said.

The Western Bulldogs Heartland Award will be given to a player who is not necessarily the best on ground or scores the most goals, but will be awarded on the basis of mateship, second efforts and commitment to the team.

The weekly winners of the Heartland Award will receive a certificate of recognition, which includes a 10% discount off all Official Western Bulldogs merchandise from the Bulldogs Shop at Whitten Oval and at Etihad Stadium on Bulldog game days.





With more than 500 people turning up to watch the Storm play practise matches during the off season, the club has more than 190 players, over 70 social club members, and more than a thousand fans on their social media site.

"This year will be about building a foundation that will hopefully set up the club to be a strong and community focussed place, where anyone who wants to be involved feels welcome," Sheppard said.

Included under the Wyndhamvale postcode, the developing Manor Lakes area saw the need for a football club, with the Wyndham Council building a sporting complex last year, in order to cope with the demand of growing sporting clubs in the district.

Running out to a big crowd under the lights of Howqua Road Reserve, there was excitement in the air, as the Storm ran out 108 point victors in their debut match against the Laverton Magpies last Saturday night.

"Regardless of the score, it will be a great reward, win, lose or draw for everyone that has been involved in getting the Storm ready for this season," Sheppard said.

The Storm's next match will be played against North Sunshine at Dempster Park, on Saturday April 13.

SANCTUARY LAKES

Great White Hope for the Sharks Community



One of the WRFL's newest additions is doing more for the local community than just putting a new team on the field.

With their club logo inspired by legendary golfer, Greg Norman, who designed the local golf course, the Sanctuary Lakes 'Sharks' are providing locals with a new avenue to continue to play the sport they love.

Established in early November last year, the Sharks have been able to provide a football outlet for approximately 700 people made up of staff, players, committee members, coaches and managers, and have 220 footballers ranging from eight years of age, right up to 40 years old.

Club President, Mark Barrett, said that due to the fast growing nature of the Point Cook district, there was a high demand for a new football club, which he was happy to be a part of.

"There was a definite need for a second football club within the area, particularly after Point Cook chose to play seniors in the Amateur Competition, another side was needed in the WRFL," Barrett said.

Identifying a lack of junior clubs in the immediate area, Rod Davis, Paul Pritchard, Paul Tyers and Seniors coach, Nick Waddell, decided a football club was needed, and were the main drivers behind the creation of the new Sanctuary Lakes Sharks.

"Due to the shortage of junior clubs, some kids were choosing other sports because they could not get regular games with local footy clubs and it was disappointing to find locals travelling outside the area just to get a game," Barrett explained.

Represented by multiple junior teams of all ages, the Division Two Seniors and Reserves made their WRFL debut last Saturday, against Sunshine Heights at Featherbrook Reserve.

Despite their 70 point loss, President Mark Barrett, believes that his club had already achieved success, well before the first bounce.

"In terms of playing matches, our success rate is really of little concern because we have already started our road to success and I think the SLFC will surprise many people in all aspects, both on and off the field," Barrett said.

Hundreds of people turned out for the round one clash, many enjoying the special pre-match entertainment by legendary singer Mike Brady, who performed his classic song "Up there Cazaly" and the new Sharks theme song.

WYN FM GOING DIGITAL

WRFL match broadcasting on 88.9 WYN FM will enter the high tech world in season 2013.

No longer relying on copper wire telephone lines, broadcasts from the WYN FM caravan this year will be done digitally and wirelessly.

This switch to digital transmission will not only improve the quality of sound, but will also avoid drop-outs experienced in landline reception in recent years.

The only downside with digital broadcasting is that it requires the signal to be buffered, meaning that there will be a five second delay between transmission and reception on the 88.9 FM frequency.

To avoid confusion for spectators watching the match at venues, a second un-buffered signal will be broadcast on a low powered transmitter, at a new frequency of 90.1FM.

So if you can't make it to the game, tune into 88.9 FM as usual, but if you wanting to listen to live and up to date commentary as a spectator at the ground, tune into 90.1FM for an un-buffered broadcast.




