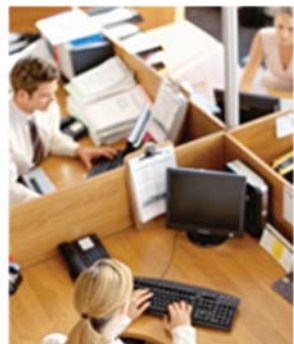

# BIGGER THAN THE GAME ITSELF



Quite possibly the most emotional and moving moment in sporting history, there was not a single dry eye in the house

when the great Ted Whitten rode around the MCG for the last time. Voted as one of the greatest moments in AFL history, the man known as Mr. Football was a legend both on and off the field.

Born and bred in Melbourne's Western suburbs with his sister Edna and brother Don, EJ was loved for his football finesse, passion for the game and his larger than life character. In his early days, Whitten played his junior football in the Footscray District Football League for the Braybrook Football Club before progressing to play in the Victorian Football League and becoming one of the most decorated footballers the game has seen.

Throughout his career, EJ's outstanding playing achievements are beyond every boyhood dream. Playing a then-league record of 321 games for Footscray Football Club in the VFL, he was Captain/Coach of Footscray for over 12 seasons. Add to that five time Best & Fairest awards, three times All-Australian, the 1954 premiership, a Legend in the AFL Hall Of Fame, Captain of the AFL Team of the Century and Bulldogs Team of the Century and the list goes on.

With the ability to play in any position on the field, EJ is undoubtedly one of the greatest players to come out of the west. Despite his talent and toughness on the field, EJ was a larrikin off the field, voted as the greatest personality in AFL history last year, ahead of Kevin Sheedy, Ron Barassi and the late Jim Stynes. He became synonymous with State of Origin football as a

passionate player and promoter of the game, which continues to live on in his memory with the Ray White EJ Whitten Legends Game.

In its eighteenth year, the Legends Game helps raises money and awareness for men's health and in particularly prostate cancer, which sadly took Ted's life in 1995.



Following his death, the EJ Whitten Foundation was formed by his son Ted Whitten Jnr to raise awareness of the disease. Ted Jnr continues to do this today, and has raised over \$7million dollars for prostate cancer research. The WRFL are proud to support the EJ Whitten Foundation as our community partner, and we thank all senior and junior clubs for their support of our fundraisers over the past month.

For those who are yet to get involved with our community partner, we urge you to head down to Etihad Stadium to watch some of the best ex-AFL stars in action, and to hopefully see the Victorian's 'stick it right up' the All Stars and see EJ's legend live on.

# FIVE MINUTES WITH TED WHITTEN JNR

**What are the key messages the EJ Whitten Foundation are pushing this year?**

Men's health awareness through the Time to Test campaign aimed at men approaching 50 reminding them to commence an annual health check.

**What has been your greatest memory thus far with the Foundation?**

It was when a guy from the Super Rules competition approached me to let me know that after listening to a talk I had given, he went for a prostate test. He found out that he had prostate cancer and because his doctor had detected it early he been able to have it treated and now he is cured. He thanked me for saving his life. That made me feel good, as we work hard at the EJ Whitten foundation to get the message across to men to help save lives.

**Do you have an idea of the amount of lives that have been saved through the Foundation's support of Prostate Cancer?**

No not really as there are thousands of men who attend our awareness events and go and have a test and find out they have prostate cancer but do not necessarily let you know. When they do tell you it is very rewarding to know that you have helped save someone's life.

**Why is the partnership with the WRFL so important for the Foundation?**

It is a great opportunity to promote our cause to the entire community of the WRFL. It's about educating men to look after themselves by having regular health checks. Not just for prostate cancer but for all, of the other health issues such as cholesterol, diabetes, liver, blood pressure, bowel cancer etc that men face as they get older. It is also important to me as all of my family played in the WRFL/FDL over many years.

**You're dad was passionate about state of origin football, do you think we should bring it back in today's game?**

I would personally like to see it come back in some form, maybe every two years. The players would all like to see it back but the clubs are against it now, as there is too much money in the game and if they lose a player to injury while playing in origin, they could lose the premiership.

**EJ was a tough footballer, who do you think is one of the toughest AFL footballers in today's game?**

I think Luke Hodge is one of the toughest going around in the AFL as he doesn't take a backward step, knows how to use his body to protect himself and never takes his eyes off the ball.

**Can you tell us a little bit about your junior playing days? Did you used to have a special pre-game ritual?**

I was generally pretty relaxed before a game but I had a few little things that I liked to do before a game. One was to go for a walk on the pier at Altona beach to get some

sea air and the other was to get to the game early to watch the reserves play so I could feel the atmosphere of the day.

**The Legends game is now in its 18th season this year, what can fans expect out of this game?**

I think it will be another fun game with plenty of skill shown by the past AFL players and

lots of laughs watching the celebrities trying to get a kick. It should be a great night again as we promote prostate cancer awareness on national television.

**What was the best piece of advice your dad ever gave you?**

My dad never interfered with my football. As a coach himself he allowed me to listen to my own coach and only offered me advice when I asked for it. Other than that he always told me to train hard and not to be lazy by taking shortcuts. He told me to practice regularly on my opposite foot and hand which I did and it helped me greatly when I made senior football with the Bulldogs. It's a long story but he also told me to never miss a footy trip- which I didn't.

**What message would you like to tell all the men out there who are yet to have a prostate check?**

Having lost my father to prostate cancer at just 62 years of age, I would recommend that all men should commence an annual health and prostate check when they reach 50 years of age. In those days, he was uneducated about the disease and generally didn't look after himself until he had a physical symptom. If they have a family history of prostate cancer as I have, I suggest they commence an annual check-up from the age of 40 because men with a family history of prostate cancer have a much higher chance of contracting the disease. Prostate Cancer that is curable often has no symptoms.

# CLUB LEGEND OF THE WEEK

## Allan 'Titch' Williams from Albion FC

Five decades, 53 seasons and over 900 games later, its clear Allan Williams is deserved of the term 'club legend'.

Better known by many in the football community as "Titch", this veteran has been servicing the Albion Football Club since its inception in 1961.

Every Saturday, there's no doubt you'll see Titch dressed in his white pants and trainers outfit ready to help out where necessary.

"My wife Loraine said that I spend more time at the club than I do at home!" Titch laughed.

Over his time as Albion's trainer, he has had to deal with multiple injuries, ranging from your usual breaks, tears and dislocations to even the more serious injuries such as spinal.

Yet no matter what the job is, it's safe to say you are in no better hands than Titch's.

And it seems his passion for community football and the Albion Football Club has rubbed off on his family, with his son Darren playing for many years, his eldest daughter Leanne running the water for over 20 years and youngest daughter Kayley watching on the sidelines at almost every game.

Dedicating more than half your life to a club, Titch has had some memorable moments throughout his career including having two club honour boards named after him, winning multiple Best Personality of the Year awards, receiving both a WRFL and Albion Life Membership and having an Australian Sports Medal bestowed upon him in 2000.

"I think there was only 100 medals given out to people throughout the country both living and deceased and I was lucky enough to get one, so that was one of my biggest accolades."

Last year, Titch also added yet another award to his long list of achievements, having been selected as the official Victorian trainer at the EJ Whitten Legends Game.

"They had heard about what I had done for the Albion Football Club and got in contact with my daughter and they worked it out between them, without telling me and then surprised me a few weeks out telling me I was to be the Vics Trainer."

This year, Titch will once again suit up for the big V in this year's Legends Game but this time, his daughter Leanne will be right there beside him, helping out with the water.

"For some reason last year the water was being a second item and Leanne just got involved and put the ice blocks in the bottles and chased around with them and so this year they have invited her back with me, which is great," he said.

"The fact that I was able to be involved with the game last year and listen to some of the stories from the old time players and rub down Fev and Strauchanie was a great thrill.

"And the atmosphere as you walk up the race with the players before the game is unbelievable, you've got to be there to understand it....you really do!"

With over 50 of the AFL's greats strapping on the boots for the first time in years, Titch is sure to have his work cut out for him again this year.

Keep an eye out for Leanne and Titch during the Legends Game when it airs live on Channel Nine at 7:30pm on Wednesday July 10.

# ITS 200 FOR TWOMEY

“You only get out of it, what you put into it.”

Hearing these inspiring words from his father when he was just a kid, it's clear Port Melbourne Colts Captain Blake Twomey has achieved a lot in his football career, playing his 200th senior game for the club last weekend.

“I didn't give it much thought to be honest, but a few days before the game I started receiving phone calls and messages from past players, current players, supporters and friends, all congratulating me and expressing some very kind words,” Twomey said.

“It was extremely overwhelming and made the day very special.”

Despite going down to St.Albans by 29-points in his milestone match, Twomey still had an impact on the game, even celebrating the occasion with a cheeky goal.

First pulling on the red and blue jumper as a kid in the under 10s team, Twomey continued to play for the Colts right up to the under 16s.

“All I remember from under 10s footy is trying to spit more than my opponent and not showering after the games,” he said.

Twomey left the club in 2000 to pursue an opportunity to play with the Western Jets under 18s TAC cup team, before playing in the reserves premiership side with the Williamstown VFL Football Club.

Yet his love for the Colts still burned strong, returning to the club in 2003 where he is now currently leading out the senior squad as captain.

Like many football players, Twomey's most memorable moment throughout his career was being part of the club's back to back premiership wins over Parkside in 2005 and arch rivals Hoppers Crossing, in 2006.

Yet besides his two premiership medallions, Twomey's other most memorable moment is an unusual one.

“It's hard to go past the feeling of winning our two premierships, but I'll never forget the day we played at West Footscray and a new player to the

club rubbed himself down with the trainer's apple juice,” he said.

Having celebrated his 30th birthday earlier this year, Twomey sees his playing career continuing on for many years to come.

“With the advances in modern science and the Port Colts incredible recovery program, it isn't unreasonable to aim for 600 games. Failing that I can see a future career in Hollywood.”

Known as one of the stalwarts of the club, Twomey puts it down to some good pre-game rituals and one simple rule when tossing the coin.

“I like to eat pasta two nights before the game, I always wear my Speedos on game day and tails never fails when it comes to tossing the coin.”

The Colts will look to make it their fourth win for the season, when they host Yarraville Seddon this Saturday afternoon at Murphy Reserve.

# UMPIRES CORNER

It sounded like a good idea to hold a twilight game when North Sunshine played host to the Albanvale Football Club last weekend. Rather than their usual start time of 12noon, the Reserves began at 3pm, with the Seniors kicking off at 5:15pm. Initially the weather was quite kind being unusually mild for the end of June. Even though there wasn't any rain around and the sun was out, the crowd was soon looking for extra layers of clothing when it eventually set.

The umpires were careful to check their appointments to ensure that they were not late for their respective games. Rene Van Kuyk and Rohan Rizzoli were in charge of the reserves game while best buddies, Paul Parker and Anthony Bermejo, ran the boundary. One of the goal umpires was Leon Stuart who was making his WRFL debut. As a first gamer, he was very impressive and showed that his football and sporting background helped him to fulfil the role of goal umpire with loads of promise.

In the seniors, Con Grouios and Peter Holding were the field umpires. Although Peter is mature in years, he is relatively new to umpiring, having only umpired for just three years. His dedication to training and improvement in his umpiring ability saw him promoted to the Division Two Seniors just a few weeks ago. On the boundary were the Tabone twins, Luke and Nathan, who ran well and officiated competently. One of the senior goalies was Emma Humphries, a young secondary student from Caroline Springs, who in only her second year goal umpiring is rapidly developing her umpiring skills and abilities. After doing seven or eight games with a mentor last season and then a series of Under 18 games, she was promoted this season and has the confidence to umpire consistently at this level.

But just when you thought the weather was kind, it was during the senior game that the Melbourne

fog was at its worst around 7:30pm. Thankfully though it came and went soon after.

The fog prompted one person who attended the match, to recall a game on Angliss Reserve in the late 1970s. It was Saturday morning and the Kingsville Under 16 team were playing on the northern oval. The fog was so thick that visibility was extremely limited. The game still went ahead even though players struggled to see each other. Billy Mathews, a St John Ambulance volunteer, wrapped in his big thick black coat, stood in the centre of the ground. He was barely visible from the goal square. Every time there was a score, the message would be passed to Bill who, in turn, would pass the message on until it reached the club goalie at the other end.

Just the week before the North Sunshine game, on the Wednesday night after training at Scovell Reserve, the goal umpires' group held their usually weekly meeting. 

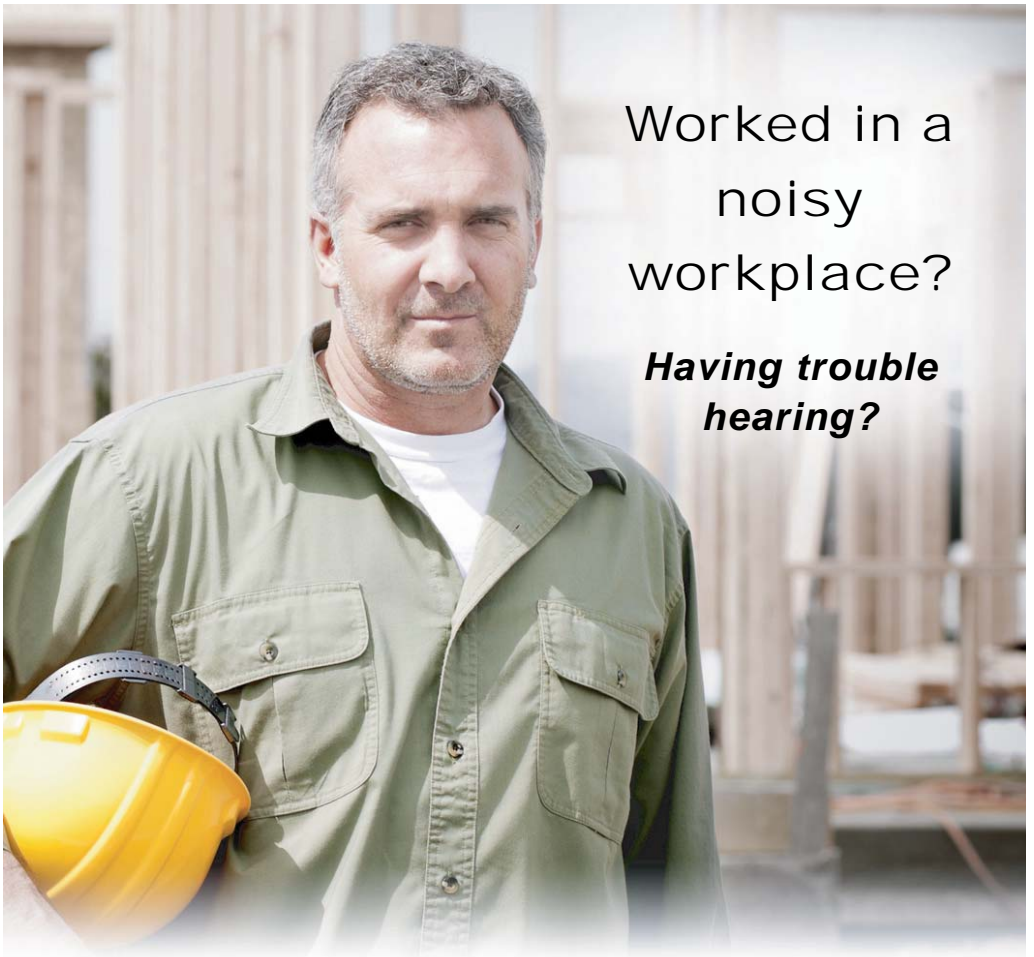
