# NAIDOC WEEK IN THE WRFL

Whilst the AFL and local football leagues across the country officially celebrate Multicultural Week over July 13-14, two clubs from the Western Region Football League have already celebrated multiculturalism within their communities, commemorating NAIDOC Week last weekend.

NAIDOC, which stands for National Aborigines and Islander Day Observance Committee, celebrates the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people both past and present, within the wider community.

Having already hosted their first Indigenous Round a few weeks ago, the Deer Park Football Club in conjunction with the Indigenous Family Violence Action Group Western Region (IFVAG) has continued to support the indigenous community by swapping their traditional yellow and blue jumpers for an aboriginal inspired one.

In their Round 12 match against the Sunshine Kangaroos last Saturday, all senior players from Deer Park wore a red, yellow and black striped gurensey to acknowledge the indigenous culture within the local community.

Deer Park President, Mark McGoldrick said that the club recognised the importance of reconciliation between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people and that this was just a small step in promoting harmony.

“We feel that we have a leadership role to play in the community and therefore are pleased to have this opportunity to demonstrate how a football club can lead the way in promoting harmony and respect between Indigenous and non-Indigenous people in our community through sport.

“In season 2013, we have approximately eight indigenous players at our club, however we are working hard with our partners to create pathways for more Indigenous people to come through DPFC and we expect the numbers to grow over the next couple of years,” McGoldrick said.

Down the road at Pennell Reserve, the Braybrook Sporting Club also celebrated NAIDOC Week by hosting the 10th Anniversary of the William Cooper Cup.

In the club’s second time hosting the event, a massive crowd turned up to see the Indigenous

Team take on the Victoria Police in a special exhibition football match.

Originating in 2003 by Gathering Places CEO Colleen Marion and in conjunction with the Victorian Police, Fire Brigade and Emergency Services, the exhibition match is played in honour of Australian Aboriginal political activist, William Cooper, who fought for aboriginal rights in the 1930s.

While the spectators enjoyed many family friendly activities including kid races, Sheriff’s bus, street surfer trailer and BBQ, the Indigenous Team enjoyed a win over the Victoria Police by eight points.

Braybrook Sporting Club Administrator, Suellen Isherwood said that the club was overwhelmed by the support from the people in the community and were proud to host the event for the second time.

“The atmosphere and support from everybody was tremendous, and it was truly a great family day out,” Isherwood said.



Dry July has introduced a Golden Ticket system, which gives the Dry Julyer or 'DJ' a night off from their duties.

"If you want a drink for one night, you can get a friend or whatever to buy you a gold pass worth \$25 that'll entitle you to drink for one night," said Green.

Green is looking to raise \$10,000 for Dry July and is already getting strong support for a great cause.

"I've had lots of people say can I donate, how do I do it? And so I said to them I'll put the container down at the club tonight and you guys just donate into that," said Green.

"Anyone can get behind it, as little as 50c you can donate, if the general football public can get behind it we'd be more than happy with that."



Who would have thought that you would find a speedway-racing duo in the peaceful estate of Manor Lakes?

Well, down at Howqua Reserve you can, with the Manor Lakes' Hunter Brothers.

31-year-old Charles Hunter began speedway-racing at the age of 16 following in the footsteps of his father and was later joined by younger brother Heath.

"It's more of a hobby. You spend up to a hundred thousand dollars on these cars and you're lucky to pick up two grand for a win," Charles said.

Originating in the 1920s in New South Wales, Speedway racing is a world-recognised motor sport, in which four riders (two teams of two) compete in a four lap race.

Speedway racing is dangerous, with the cars having limited suspension and the acceleration to match Formula One cars.

But this certainly doesn't deter the boys as they have been participating in the sport for fifteen years. Fortunately they haven't sustained any serious injuries, except for a broken hand and multiple car crashes on the course.

It is obvious given the expense of this sport that the boys are passionate about what they do, especially since it includes a lot of travel.

"We compete in Avalon, Warrnambool, Mt Gambier, Parramatta and Adelaide," Charles said.

Skills in speedway take time to develop, which Charles argues makes him naturally the better of the two.

"I'd like to say I'm better but Heath would probably argue that he is better at football," Charles said.

Heath landed the coaching position at Manor Lakes and Charles made the decision to sign with the club's senior team to be coached and play alongside his brother.

Not even a year into its existence, the new club is playing exceptional football, currently sitting in third position on the Division Two Senior ladder, with 11 wins to their name.

Football has been a constant since these boys were very young and they both love playing in a team.

The cooperative nature of football is such a contrast


"Certainly very different to umpiring in the WRFL where the crowd might consist of player's parents."
